The curriculum at BBIH is regularly reviewed to meet national and local changes but also provides opportunities for success for all our students.

Our curriculum is dynamic; new initiatives, combinations of subjects, innovative approaches are included to maximise the learning of our students.

Rigorous planning, monitoring and evaluating aim to meet the needs of all groups of students.

Students have benefited from our flexible approach. Attainment and achievement have improved. The KS4 and KS5 offers are reviewed annually to ensure they meet the needs of each year group.

The curriculum also meets the needs of students who experience learning difficulties and those for whom English is a second language. Support is offered in our curriculum structure while additional support is delivered through a range of personalised interventions. More able students also benefit from interventions to offer additional challenge. They also follow an enrichment programme.

We aim to inform Parents as much as possible about our Curriculum. A Curriculum Information Evening is held at the start of the two key stages, Parents are given information about the subjects and strategies to support their child at key points of their education. Through presentations and individual discussion with key staff, these evenings provide opportunities for Parents to gain a better understanding of the curriculum demands.
