4 mandatory units:

- 01 Introduction to business and enterprise
- 02 Marketing for business and enterprise
- 03 Finance for business and enterprise
- 04 Plan outline and take part in a business or enterprise project

Assessment structure:

Evidence/ assignment based with no exam.

To be awarded NCFE level one students must complete the 4 mandatory units and must successfully demonstrate their achievement in all learning outcomes and assessment criteria.

If a student completes one whole unit successfully a unit certificate can be requested.

Grades are awarded for this qualification and the grading system is pass, merit, distinction and distinction*.

Each unit is assessed and graded by centre assessors and a reasonable sample is checked by an internal moderator. Grades are submitted to and an external moderator will then visit and verify the grades.

Once the unit grades are sent to NCFE the final grades will be issued to the centre from NCFE.

The table below shows how the accumulation of each unit grade is aggregated to form the overall qualification grade.
