Course Description for NCFE CACHE Level 2 award in Health and Social Care

Description

The Level 2 Award in Health and Social Care will enable learners to develop their knowledge and understanding of the health and social care sector.

Assessment

To gain this qualification, learners must achieve a

minimum of a Pass grade in each of the 3 internal mandatory assessments

(externally set, internally marked) and the external synoptic assessment (externally set, externally marked). Coursework is marked as a Pass, Merit or Distinction.

There is a maximum of two opportunities for learners to attempt the external assessment in order to achieve a pass grade or improve a grade.

Out of class learning including home-learning

Learners will be expected to complete homework on a weekly basis which will consist of research, reading or written tasks. Students can also complete coursework/homework at the coursework catch-up club on Tuesday's 3pm-4pm.

How parents can help

- Parents/carers can ensure their child comes equipped to class.
- Parents/carers can support students by checking and signing planners every week to check that homework has been completed.
- Parents/carers can also encourage students to attend coursework catch-up classes to get extra support with their coursework/homework.
