History Entry Level is an applied course where students submit a mixture of assignments and only 2 controlled assessments

Embedded within will be the Explore Heritage Marketing course. The emphasis would be on working in teams, problem solving, planning & use of digital literacy, acquire WRL skills such as computer literacy, presentation, creation of media products, writing up surveys and a business plan as part of an events management team following an enrichment visit.

This subject is most suitable for students who:

- Are well motivated, have an interest in the past and a desire to learn more.
- Are prepared to challenge ideas and analyse a variety of sources.
- Are able to plan and maintain a personal folder
- Will participate in educational visits



ASSESSMENT METHOD

- Coursework and Teacher assessed 33.3%
- Examination 66.6%

- How to use language and dates, and vocabulary and conventions when writing about historical periods and the passing of time
- Key features of historical periods: life, beliefs and events
- Key concepts in an historic al context: causation, change, results and significance
